Signing On

In person scrutineering is required on the Saturday afternoon for all novice drivers and the entire Inter-Max Class. Scrutineering for these drivers is available from 3pm until after the last practice of the day. Once you have been scrutineered, you may not go back out for practice.

2024 Motorsport UK Karting Yearbook – Amendment 4

The following amendments, shown in red text, are made to the 2024 Motorsport UK Karting Yearbook with immediate effect:

Rotax Spark Plugs

B4.2.9 and C4.2.9 Spark Plug. The only spark plugs permitted are as listed and must be unmodified with sealing washer in place: 1.20mm feeler gauge must not fit between the two electrodes:

NGK GR8DI, GR9DI

At Club meetings only (App 4 B14) until 31.07.2024: Denso IW24, IW27

Other makes/types may be added to this list by J.A.G. Engineering, details will be published in official bulletin.

D2.4.8 and E2.4.8 Spark Plug. The only spark plugs permitted are as listed below and must be unmodified with sealing washer in place:

NGK GR8DI or GR9DI

At Club meetings only (App 4 B14) until 31.07.2024: Denso IW24, IW27

Other makes/types may be added to this list by J.A.G.; details will be published in official bulletin.

Reason for amendment: Use of Denso plugs reinstated for Club meetings only, due to limitations in supply of Rotax NGK plugs.
